9	Adjuvants / oils	BS1000, Hasten [®] , Uptake [®]	BS1000	Add non-water conditioning adjuvants and oils last. Add water to 100% of desired volume. Do not allow mixtures to stand unagitated. Mateno Complete mixtures should not be left overnight. Adjuvants/oils can increase crop effects when used with Mateno Complete EPE, only add an adjuvant/oil where required by a compatible product.

IMPORTANT: some mixes that are compatible with continuous agitation may not be compatible if agitation stops. Finish spraying before moving to other activities. Do not leave product in the tank overnight, maintain continuous agitation when checking nozzles or repairing boom breakdowns.

PLEASE NOTE

- It is not recommended to mix Mateno Complete with other crop protection products when used EPE in barley.
- Using higher water volumes around 80-100 L/ha generally results in better physical compatibility outcomes.
- · Using 50 mesh filters may result in better performance and handling in the sprayer.
- · Minimise the number of products in a tank-mix to maximise compatibility.
- · If unsure of physical compatibility, conduct a jar test with the same field ratios.
- Note: physical compatibility does not imply biological compatibility.
- · Cleaning should occur immediately following the last application of Mateno Complete, or if the sprayer is not used for several hours. When tank-mixing Mateno Complete with another product, use the more rigorous recommended cleanup of the products in the tank mix.
